

1. Since 31st December 2023, how many incidents have you attended, that has involved dogs of a banned breed type?

869 dangerous dog non-crime numbers – please note: we only started recording this 29th April 2024

2. Since 31st December 2023, how many dogs have you seized for being a suspected banned breed type?

We have encountered 759 - not all of these were seized

3. How many banned breed types, have died whilst being held in police approved kennels, since December 31st 2023?

4. How many banned breed types, have been destroyed at the scene of an incident by your firearms officers since December 31st 2023?

5. The cost of policing dangerous dog incidents, has said to have risen since 31st December 2023. The interim exemption scheme is available to all forces, would this be something you would consider implementing to reduce those associated costs?

We do utilise the IES where appropriate to do so. 35 dogs are currently on the IES. In order for a dog to be on the IES it needs to be neutered / insured / microchipped - many of the dogs are not and therefore the IES can't be utilised until they are.
